YOUNG INVESTIGATOR AWARDS Criteria

- Submit at least one abstract as a presenting author
- Be a trainee, within 2 years of completion of your training/fellowship
- Be a member of TTS
- Submit a supporting letter as part of the travel grant application
- Attend the President's Plenary at the Congress to receive the award









YOUNG INVESTIGATOR AWARDS Process

Application Deadline: December 8, 2017

- Awardees selected based on abstract's degree of excellence
- Awards may not exceed a maximum amount of \$2,000 US
- Effort made to award at least one grant to an applicant from each of the 6 geographic regions of TTS

MENTEE-MENTOR AWARDS Goals

- Foster the training of new young investigators in the basic science of transplantation
- Promote research in the basic science of transplantation
- Encourage dialogue and interactions between trainees and established investigators at TTS 2018









MENTEE-MENTOR AWARDS Eligibility

- Graduate student or post-doc within 5 years of receiving
 PhD or MD degree
- Must be conducting basic science/lab research
- Be first presenting author of a submitted abstract at TTS 2018
- Be an active member of TTS and your national society
- Must attend TTS 2018









MENTEE-MENTOR AWARDS Process

- Submit an abstract
- Letter from department chair

- Sign-up to Lunch & Learn Sessions will be available during online registration.










IN MADRID Science and Socializing


